

APPLICATION FOR SEASONAL EMPLOYMENT 2024

Thank you for your interest in seasonal work with Tully Sugar.

Please find attached an “Application Form” and “General Physical Requirements of Seasonal Positions”. All of which are required to be completed to be considered for seasonal employment. You should consider all of the information provided before deciding whether to proceed with an application for seasonal work.

Length of Seasonal Work

The crushing season normally commences early June through to November/December each year depending on our crop size and weather conditions.

Fitness for Duty Program

Prior to being offered work at Tully Sugar Limited you will be required to provide either a urine or saliva sample that will be tested at the Company’s expense for the presence of illicit drugs.

Smoke free workplace

Smoking is not permitted on Company worksites.

Hours of Work

The majority of seasonal positions involve shift work:

- Working a 4 shift continental 7 day continuous 8 hour shift roster. The shifts are day shift (7.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m.), afternoon shift (3.00 p.m. to 11.00 p.m.) and night shift (11.00 p.m. to 7.00 a.m.). 5 days are worked out of the seven and you have one weekend off in the month; or
- Working a lifestyle 12hr shift roster over a 4 week period.

You may be asked to work overtime from time to time but overtime is not guaranteed by the Company.

Wages as at 1.04.2023

Entry level, working day work only is paid \$1178.02 gross per week – net \$954.

Entry level on shift work is paid an average of \$1,598.83 per week – net \$1,229, over a four week shift cycle.

You will accumulate annual leave entitlements during the season in addition to the above weekly wage.

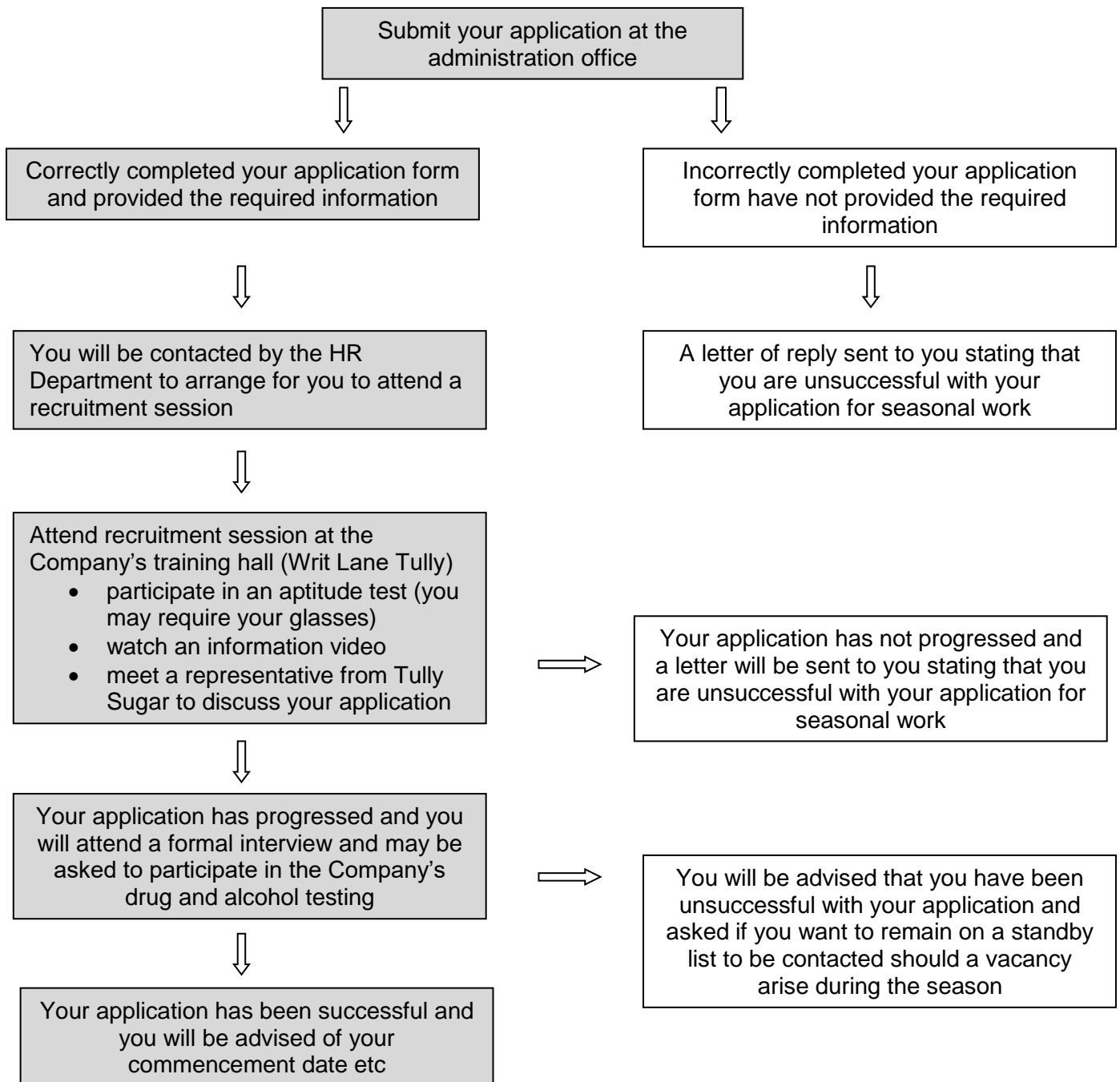
Clothing – supplied by the Company
